## Cantor's Corner...

🎵 Notes From the Cantor 🎵

The world is completely different for our community than it was a month ago. A lengthy festival season ended and immediately gave way to intense horror, fear, anger, anxiety, trauma, stress, and eventually exhaustion. With anti-Semitism on the rise on some college campuses and elsewhere around the world, many of us are understandably disturbed. All of this makes it hard to look ahead to the secular Thanksgiving holiday in America. There are some who may even have a valid objection to the historical rationale given to elementary school children about why Thanksgiving is celebrated. Objections to the whitewashing of history are duly noted. That being said, for some of the same reasons why American Jews have always celebrated Thanksgiving, doing so now is more important than ever before. I am not talking about fressing on tryptophan and zonking out in front of an NFL game, so much as I am talking about gathering together to ask the Lord's blessing. Yes, this is a quote from a hymn somewhere. It may not have been one of our

hymns originally. Nor may it be in the updated, gender neutral, verbiage to which we, as Reform Jews, have grown accustomed. However, at least the first one or two verses have important non-sectarian value. In these divisive times, we especially need to gather. College students are coming home from hostile environments and need to be with family. One of the texts being cited by the Reform Movement in response to rough, challenging, stressful, times is a mash-up of quotes centered around Micah 6:8 in the prophetic portion of the Tanakh, and Pirkei Avot 2:16: "Do not be daunted by the enormity of the world's grief. Do justly, now. Love mercy, now. Walk humbly, now. You are not obligated to complete the work, neither are you free to abandon it." We sometimes sing that last part on page 645 of Mishkan Tefilah. It is sometimes better to give yourself a break, at least for a few moments, from the 24/7 news cycle. ("But Cantor, what do you think my family talks about at Thanksgiving?") At least take the time to appreciate good food and hopefully good company, and remember that there is always something for which to be thankful. In fact, the name of our religion, Judaism, or in Hebrew, "Ya-ha-doot" is after the tribe of Judah, or Ye-hu-dah, whose mother was "thankful" that he was born. "Judaism" or "Ya-ha-doot", in a way, means "Thanksgiving."

# From the President...

To My Temple Family,

As you know, there has been a growing expression of antisemitism in this country as noted in the hate speech appearing on social media, on college campuses, and through vandalism of Jewish intuitions. Such behaviors are a concern to us, and therefore your Temple leadership has begun to address concerns for the safety of our synagogue and our fellow congregants and staff while in our sanctuary and office areas. To that end I have discussed security concerns with our landlord and the Springfield Police Department. As I informed you in a prior communication, the Springfield Police are patrolling the parking lot at our facility. Further, I have noted the presence of the police as they patrol the area, and the presence of a police car in the parking lot during Shabbat evening services. Additionally, I have registered with Jewish Federation Metro-West to receive their security alerts and updates, which appear in my email several times a week. I have asked Amy Kass, a member of our former Security Committee, to join me in reviewing/revising our TSS Security Plan. Amy and I will keep you informed of security planning as we move forward.

On a personal note, as some of you know the Moesch Family has an extended family in Israel. Currently, our eighteen-year-old granddaughter is living, studying, and volunteering in Israel. Beginning on October 7, our granddaughter has spent time in bomb shelters, moving from location to more secure locations, communicating with her Israeli family, including her cousins who are on active duty in the IDF, and keeping us informed of her daily activities and security concerns. We also have a daughter-in-law whose entire family reside in Israel. She too keeps us informed of the impacts of the current situation on her family, inclusive of the call-up of her nephews as part of the IDF reserve force. Sharon has several cousins who reside in Israel and communicate with her on their personal security status, and the call-up of their children and grandchildren to active duty. So, my friends, we all have a strong connection to Israel, the threats to us as a Jewish people, and our need to concern ourselves with the health, safety, and well-being of our Jewish community. Sharon and I extend

our heart felt thank you to those of you who know our Israeli connections and have expressed your concerns for the safety of our loved ones.

On a lighter note, a few of your fellow congregants have followed a lead to the possible acquisition of a portable Ark for our Sanctuary. At this writing, discussions have moved forward in a productive manner, and may soon conclude with the actual acquisition of the Ark and its placement in our sanctuary. We will keep you informed on the status of this exciting endeavor. A special thank you to Edie Ben Israel, Ellen Lieberman, and Pam Bain for their tenacious follow-up on the initial lead.

Our Sisterhood has just concluded a fund drive for Mogan David Adom, which reportedly lost a number of ambulances, medical equipment, and medical supplies during the initial attack on October 7. This endeavor by the Sisterhood is extremely important for the health and welfare of Israel. A special thank you to the members of the Sisterhood for making the decision to support Mogan David Adom and putting their thoughts into action.

We have developed a new Activities & Planning Committee that is in the process of developing programming ideas that will be offered to us over the coming months. Your fellow congregants who have volunteered to serve on the committee include Mara Friedman, Amy Kass, Sue Marcus, Doreen Salerno, Dayle Treece, and Ron Weening. I thank them for their willingness to serve, and look forward to enjoying the programs and activities that they develop for us.

My friends, we are an active congregation that is addressing many issues that are important to us. Many of you have already volunteered your time, expertise, and love to our Jewish community. We are proving that we are "the little Temple that can..." May we continue our efforts on our own behalf and for the survival and growth of the Jewish people.
